### Educational goals:

The course organizer is the ESPGHAN Committee on Nutrition. The focus is on reviewing the current knowledge on pediatric enteral nutrition (EN) in different settings (NICU, PICU, pediatric wards). Aim of the course is to gather different specialties treating children requiring EN and discuss modalities, type of feed and possible complication. Clinical cases will be presented by both the faculty and the participants. Thus, participants are asked to submit clinical case prior to the course, and selected cases will be presented and discussed during the course.

### Travel and accommodation:

Participants are expected to pay their own travel, and to pay a nominal fee of 50€ for the course. The fee includes accommodation and food as well as the social activities and course.
