

Short Curriculum Vitae Prof. Reinier Hoff M.D. Ph.D.

Reinier Hoff did his medical training at Utrecht University and postgraduate training in Anesthesiology and Intensive Care at the University Medical Center (UMC) Utrecht, The Netherlands. After this training he worked for ten years (1998-2008) as a consultant-intensivist at the Intensive Care Center of the UMC Utrecht. In this period he further specialized in neuro-intensive care. In 2008 he transferred to the Department of Anesthesiology in the same hospital, to work as a consultant in neuro-anesthesia and emergency medicine. In 2009 he finished his PhD thesis on the topic of intravascular volume after subarachnoid hemorrhage. He has held several managerial positions e.g. medical head of the Surgical Medium Care Unit, medical head of the Operating Room Complex, and interim head of the Department of Emergency Medicine. In 2010 he was appointed as deputy program director and in 2012 as program director of the anesthesiology residency, a position he still holds. In 2016 Reinier Hoff was appointed as a full professor at Utrecht University in the field of Education and Training in Perioperative, Intensive and Emergency Care. His current research projects focus on the assessment of clinical performance and on interprofessional education.
